Hello friends, Running Blind members and supporters! 2020 was a tough year for everyone with Covid running rampant, and that included Running Blind. We suspended most of our activities for the year, as pairing new runners was not really feasible, and with a minimum of support in general, I've been kinda running on fumes lately on this and some other things in my life. How to regenerate some energy and enthusiasm for the paring work that we did for some years will be a challenge. One pair of runners is still going strong however – that being *Sile O'Modhrain and her guide Mikel Rubio*. They have been paired up for about 4 years and have set a record by far for the longest lasting pair of any we have helped set up. (Most pairing seem to last about 6 months it seems, for various reasons.)
